AIMS of the conference

On 2015, “Safeguarding Human Health in the Anthropocene Epoch”, a publication of the Rockefeller Foundation-Lancet Commission report, proposed to shift from usual segmented approaches to improving human health to a systems approach, the so called “Planetary Health”. This approach stresses the necessity of interconnecting human health with the health of the global ecosystem, because, in truth, they are just one. Therefore, more topics, apart from human health, should be considered, such as climate changes; energy transition; circular economy and nutrition, without forgetting social themes such as inclusion and equality. The role of new tools, such as artificial intelligence and quantum technologies, to support the actions to reach the final objectives, requires specific attention to identify their safe role with an open mind.

Moreover, new transdisciplinary strategies, rather than the “parallel play” of multidisciplinary, must be planned for education and research, in order to actualize the approach.

The Napoli Conference aims to discuss the way of facing these big challenges, comparing the position of EAPE’s members with that of top quality scientists, experts in different fields. Moreover, the debate will collect the position of the young generation, as generational gap and communication difficulties are one of the main problems to be faced to improve the Planetary Health.

To this purpose, the Conference is structured in Sessions: Planetary health, Intergenerational communication; Prevision, Prevention, Emergency; Artificial intelligence and Robotics; Healthy aging; Mental health and neurological diseases; Education; Energy and technology; The future of medicine; A special Session on Vaccination; A Round Table on the role of professors emeriti in Europe.
